Pathfinder Law Explained

1. **Keep:** Prayer, bible study and devotions daily. I will keep the morning watch because it is the plan of God to enrich my life and prepare me for his kingdom
2. **Do:** develop our character according to Gods words and instructions. “The world does not so much need men of great intellect as of noble character” (Education page 225)
3. **Care:** My body is the temple of the holy spirit and I am responsible for caring for it. What are some of the ways we can care for our bodies?
4. **Keep:** No matter where we are in life we can always look Jesus in the eye and not be afraid. God is all seeing and knowing. He sees all things and knows all things. We should strive daily to live in a way that pleases God.

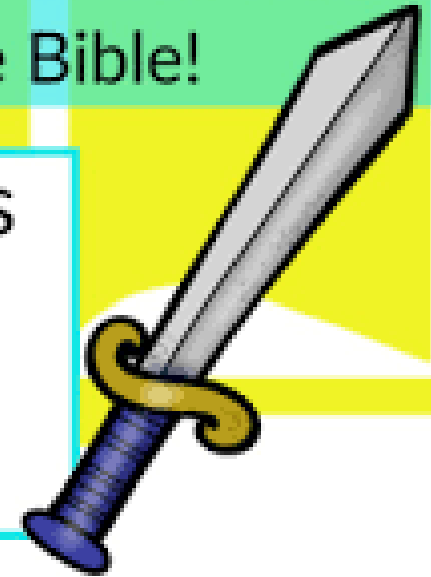
