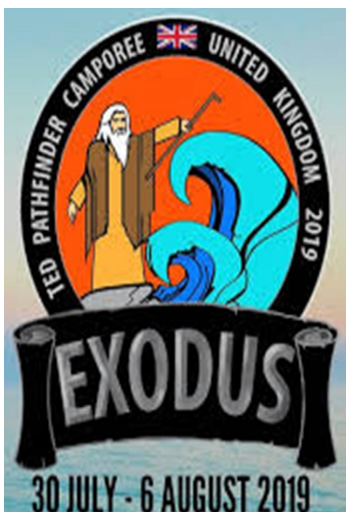
Welcome to our Pathfinder Newsletter!!
